HIPAA Letter

Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act

The HIPAA letter pertains only to projects that will collect Protected Health Information (PHI).

If a project will collect (PHI), the Privacy Officer of the organization where PHI will be collected is required to provide a letter to the UI IRB. The letter must include the Privacy Officer's understanding of their responsibilities related to HIPAA and how it may relate to this particular research project.

Below is a sample letter that may be used to document compliance with the HIPAA Privacy Rule.

We are also aware of that we must provide to our patients, upon request, an accounting of disclosures of their PHI under a waiver of authorization per 45 CFR 164.528, <i>Accounting of disclosures of protected health information</i> .
This letter confirms that a waiver of authorization has been approved by our Privacy Board for the project named above.
